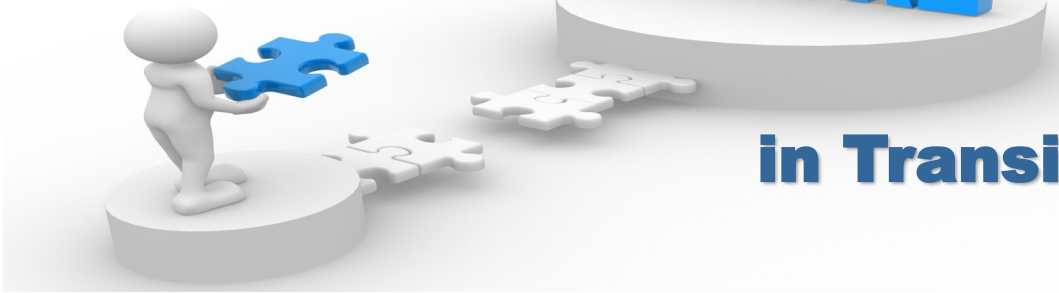


Planning for the
