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The Workers' Educational Association is piloting a programme to support skilled, experienced and qualified Midlands residents who have English as a second language to improve their English, thereby improving their chances of gaining skilled employment. The WEA will be working with Midlands Engine and the local enterprise partnerships to improve employment prospects and productivity in the work place.

Key features of the programme:

- ▶ Courses are free thanks to the support of Midlands Engine
- ▶ Intensive work place related English teaching (12 to 15 hours a week)
- ▶ Flexible learning around work patterns
- ▶ High ability groups
- ▶ Meet local business and employers
- ▶ Opportunity to achieve a recognised ESOL qualification

The WEA will be piloting in Leicester, Nottingham and Birmingham and is looking to partner with refugee centres, business and Job Centre Plus to recruit potential students.
